Committee Member, Ray Smith, and several non-committee members have offered to help when needed at events such as the Spring and Autumn Show and the Trading Hut – these members will be allocated a role ie: stewards, setting up the hall, helping in the kitchen, Trading Hut Rota and any other duties accordingly.

Two main problems highlighted are finding someone to take on the Role as Show Manager and whether the Trading Hut is to continue due to lack of interest.

The role of Show Manager could be split with several members taking on the duties as listed above and at the AGM in March we will be asking for more members to come forward to take on these roles.

The Trading Hut opened in 1985: it was a viable business for many years and provided a healthy income for the club, including a substantial financial bonus when a supplier closed down. Unfortunately, times have changed; running the Trading Hut has been a problem for some time with sales decreasing. The many garden centres and cheaper outlets such as B&Q, Homebase, Poundland and even the Supermarkets offer a greater choice for members to stock up on their gardening sundries. It has also been difficult finding members to man the Hut on a Sunday from 10am to 12 midday.

Members have not been supporting the Hut as they did in the past and looking over recent sales, it appears that it is the committee members who use the Hut the most! There is minimal profit from the sales and when the weekly rent is taken into account, there is little financial gain. After lengthy discussion it was agreed that from February 2020, we would open the Hut at the Monday meetings from 7.30pm to 8.00pm to see if this increased sales. We will also be asking for a show of hands at the AGM in March to ask:

- a) To keep the Hut open or close it.
- b) If the decision is to keep it open would they support the Hut if we stocked items they required
- c) What items they would like to see on the shelves

We will be ordering the stock as usual in January to re-open in February but should the vote in March be against continuing, the Hut will be run down slowly and eventually closed. The present stock will be sold off and the Parish Council will be informed of the decision so that they can decide as to how they will use the Hut in the future.

We look forward to seeing you at the Christmas Social on Monday 9th December (buffet included) when the club will celebrate our 75th Anniversary. There will be a Fun quiz on Monday January 13th (bring your own drink and nibbles) and the speaker booked for Monday February 10th is Mike Abel to talk about 'Biological Control and Non-Pesticide Control'.

Please make every effort to attend the AGM on March 11th 2020.

We hope the club will continue for many years to come **BUT** this will only happen with more members and more members willing to commit their time to the committee.
